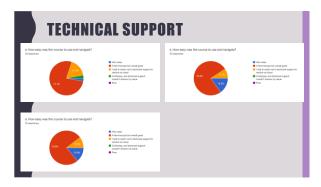












DID YOU CONNECT WITH OTHER LEARNERS (SHARING IDEAS, RESOURCES)? WHY OR WHY NOT?

- No.The two hours we were supposed to set aside for learning isn't ideal, especially when you work long stressful hours.
- It needs a lot of effort in time management. Also, some flexibility to make use of the vacant time slot from my daily routine.
